

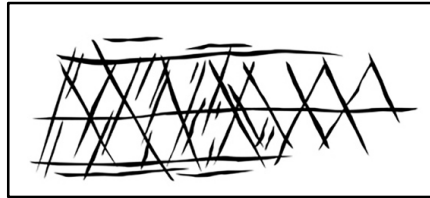

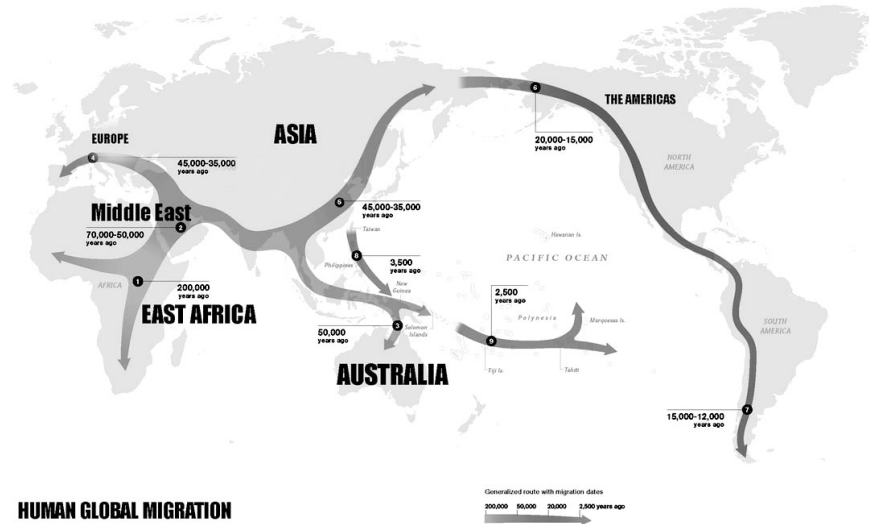

ROCK Art (20,000 years ago), Blombos Art (70,000 years ago), Nubia Art (4,000 years ago)



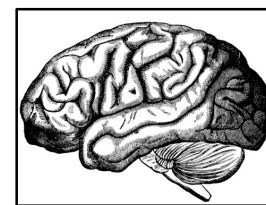
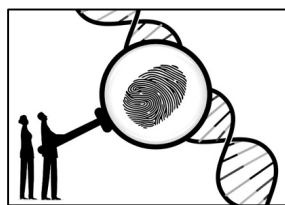
**MAP of Human Migration:**
